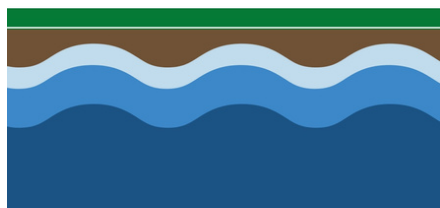

The Monroe County Soil and Water Conservation District is excited to once again offer repurposed, food grade rain barrels for sale through Upcycle Products, Inc.

Upcycle Products, Inc. uses Food Quality High Density Poly Ethylene Barrels that were previously used to ship pickled foods. Each barrel is cleaned by rinsing with rain water and a PH neutral soap so you never have to worry about harsh containments getting on your plants.

Each barrels comes in with two pieces:

The barrel: which has a garden hose spigot at the bottom to allow you to have several options: garden hose, landscape tubing or drip tubing.

The lid: Screws on like a mason jar and each has a screen to help keep out debris and to keep mosquitoes out of the water.
